

### DESCRIPTION

AD-Remover is formulated to remove all flooring adhesives including wet and cured urethane adhesives from most pre-finished (not waxed) flooring surfaces and tools.

### FEATURES AND ADVANTAGES

- Use for fast and easy spot clean-up
- Will not harm most finishes
- Removes all flooring adhesives including wet or cured urethanes
- Biodegradable

### DIRECTION FOR USE

#### Where to use:

Residential and commercial, indoor.

1. Unscrew container cover, remove and discard foam seal. From center of roll, pull up corner of towel, twist to a point and thread through hole in underside of cover. Replace cover tightly. Pull up towel and tear at perforation.
2. Rub area of floor that has cured or wet adhesive using a towel.
3. If the adhesive has cured for more than 48 hours, remove the excess of the film without scratching the surface, leaving only the minimum of adhesive. Lay a towel over the cured adhesive and let stand approximately 5 minutes. Wipe cleaned area with a fresh towel.
4. Wipe entire cleaned area with a clean, water-dampened cloth or Fini-tech cleaning products.
5. Close cap after use.

**NOTE:** It is recommended to use gloves.
