MAINTENANCE - SOLID AND ENGINEERED HARDWOOD FLOORING

CARING FOR YOUR LAUZON HARDWOOD FLOOR

Your Lauzon hardwood floor is an investment that can be protected quite easily by knowing a few basic facts and by following a few simple guidelines. In this document, you'll discover the steps you can take to ensure your Lauzon hardwood floor beauty and value are maintained for many years.

• Proper control of relative humidity is essential to a "healthy" home environment.

Maintain a relative humidity in your home between:

- 30-80% if you have an EXPERT Lauzon hardwood floor;
- 35-65% if you have an Engineered Lauzon hardwood floor;
- 35-55% if you have a Solid Lauzon hardwood floor.
- Regularly sweep or vacuum the floor and clean using a hardwood-recommended cleanser.
- Never use wax, oil-based detergent or any general-purpose household cleanser. These can dull or damage the finish, leaving
 a greasy film and making your hardwood floor slippery and more difficult to clean properly.
- Never pour cleaner directly onto your hardwood floor.
- Never wet mop your hardwood floor.
- Never allow a liquid spill to remain on your hardwood floor.
- Install doormats at all entrances to protect your hardwood floor against abrasive dirt and moisture. Vacuum or shake out mats regularly.
- Use felt protectors or barrel-type coasters under all furniture to protect your hardwood floor against scratches and indentations. Do not use plastic coasters.
- The use of area rugs (around sink and dishwasher and other similar areas) is strongly recommended to protect your hardwood floor from water and heavy traffic.
- Beware of sharp objects and damaged high heels that can permanently scratch your hardwood floor. Encourage your family and visitors to remove them.
- Refrigerators and other heavy objects should never be moved without proper floor protection. Place them on a rug, wrong side up, and slide the rug.
