Recommended Tools

- Indoor/Outdoor premium adhesive
- V-notched trowel (follow adhesive manufacturer's recommendation)

Installation Instructions

During the installation, ambient temperature must be within the range of 65°F and 95°F (18 °C and 35 °C).

Ensure the surface is flat and level before installing the carpet. Any rough surfaces have to be repaired using appropriate floor patch and/or leveler.

Before placing the carpet, the adhesive must be allowed time to tack (follow adhesive manufacturer's recommendations). If you put the carpet on the adhesive when it has not come to a properly tacked state, it could bleed through to the surface of the carpet. Do not let the adhesive dried past the proper tack, or apply it when humidity levels are too high, because it can cause adherence failure and the installed product could move and/or wrinkle with traffic.

Do not use a weighted roller on needle felt carpet. It should be rolled using the carpet core or the flat edge of a push broom to avoid adhesive bleed through to the carpet's surface.

Ensure the carpet is installed with the pile running in the same direction when you need to use more than 1 piece.

Do not walk on the carpet for a minimum of 24 hours after the installation.

HOMEOWNER OBLIGATIONS

To maintain warranty coverage and ensure fast and easy warranty service, the homeowner is responsible for the following:

- Keep 2 sq. ft. (0.2 m²) of excess unused carpet remnant after installation for testing purposes
- Keep and be able to provide the original sales receipt or documentation illustrating proof of purchase and installation date of the carpet
- Make sure the carpet is installed according to our Needle Felt Carpet Installation Guide
- Keep a list of products used to clean the carpet
