- · Do not use on exterior applications.
- Do not use in projects subject to prolonged water immersion or exposure (pools, fountains, shower floors, steam rooms, etc.).
- Do not use over presswood, oriented strand board (OSB), particleboard, chipboard, Masonite, Lauan, or other dimensionally unstable materials.
- Do not use when the ambient and/or substrate temperature is below 4°C (40°F).
- Do not use for setting glass mosaic tiles, Rosso Levanto, Negro Marquina marble, green marble or granite or their agglomerates.
- Do not use as a concrete repair mortar, concrete patching material or skim-coating compound, or to level subfloors.
- Do not use to install tile over existing tile or on laminate surfaces.
- Not recommended for setting natural stone, glass or agglomerate tiles; floor tiles larger than 15 x 15 cm (6" x 6"); or wall tiles larger than 25 x 25 cm (10" x 10").
